6	Section 1. G.S. 105-164.13 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"(13b) Sales of prescription drugs to a person to be used by a physician or
8	dentist in treating a patient."
9	Sec. 2. G.S. 105-164.3 is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
10	"(11a) 'Prescription drug' has the same meaning as in G.S. 106-121."
11	Sec. 3. This act becomes effective September 1, 1995.
