13 14 Section 1. The Legislative Research Commission may study the requirement that a lienholder pay all property taxes due on a mobile home prior to being allowed to obtain a permit to move the mobile home being repossessed. The Commission may study the issues addressed in the First Edition of House Bill 1067, in addition to any other issues as set out in this section.

- Sec. 2. The Legislative Research Commission may report to the 1996 Regular Session of the 1995 General Assembly or to the 1997 General Assembly, or both.
  - Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
