1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW FELONY OFFENSE OF ASSAULT INFLECTING  
3 SERIOUS BODILY INJURY AS RECOMMENDED BY THE NORTH CAROLINA  
4 SENTENCING AND POLICY ADVISORY COMMISSION.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new  
7 section to read:

8 "**§ 14-32.4. Assault inflicting serious bodily injury.**

9 Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing greater  
10 punishment, any person who assaults another person and inflicts serious bodily injury is  
11 guilty of a Class F felony. 'Serious bodily injury' is defined as bodily injury that creates a  
12 substantial risk of death, or that causes serious permanent disfigurement, coma, a  
13 permanent or protracted condition that causes extreme pain, or permanent or protracted  
14 loss or impairment of the function of any bodily member or organ, or that results in  
15 prolonged hospitalization."

16 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective June 30, 1997, and applies to offenses  
17 committed on or after that date.
