A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROHIBIT HUNTING FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF POWELL ROAD IN CRAVEN COUNTY AND TO PROHIBIT HUNTING FROM THE RIGHT-OF-WAY OF PUBLIC ROADS IN NORTHAMPTON COUNTY. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird on, from, or across the right-of-way of Powell Road (State Road 1477) in Craven County. Sec. 2. It is unlawful to hunt, take, or kill any wild animal or wild bird with a firearm on, from, or across the right-of-way of any public road or highway in Northampton County.
Sec. 3. Violation of this act is a Class 3 misdemeanor. Sec. 4. This act is enforceable by law enforcement officers of the Wildlife Resources Commission, by sheriffs and deputy sheriffs and by other peace officers with general subject matter jurisdiction. Sec. 5. This act becomes effective December 1, 1996.
