1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE SALE OF LOOSE, UNPACKED CIGARETTES.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. G.S. 105-113.17 reads as rewritten:

5 "**§ 105-113.17. Identification of ~~dispensers.~~ dispensers; sale of loose cigarettes**
6 **prohibited.**

7 (a) Dispensers. – Each vending machine that dispenses cigarettes must be marked
8 to identify its owner in the manner required by the Secretary.

9 (b) Prohibition. – It is unlawful to sell loose, unpacked cigarettes."

10 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995, and applies to offenses
11 occurring on or after that date.
