A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE FEE FOR INVENTORY OF SAFE DEPOSITS OF A DECEDENT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 7A-307(b1) reads as rewritten:

"(b1) The clerk shall assess the following miscellaneous fees:

(1) Filing and indexing a will with no probate

– first page \$ 1.00

– each additional page or fraction

thereof .25

(2) Issuing letters to fiduciaries, per letter over five

letters issued 1.00

(3) ~~Inventory of safe deposits of a~~

~~decedent, per box, per day~~ 15.00

(4) Taking a deposition 5.00

(5) Docketing and indexing a will probated in another county in the State

– first page 1.00

1 – each additional page or fraction
2 thereof .25".
3 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996, and applies to estate
4 administration proceedings initiated on or after that date.
