13 14 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the State Bureau of Investigation, Department of Justice, the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$125,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to establish permanent, statewide, multidisciplinary training for the investigation and prosecution of child sexual abuse pursuant to G.S. 7A-543. This training will be available to law enforcement personnel, including the State Bureau of Investigation, social workers, health care providers, mental health providers, court officials, and other professionals who serve children and families.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
