A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO EXTEND EXPIRING PROVISIONS AGAIN.
The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SALARIES/GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES

Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 358 of the 1995 Session Laws, as amended by Chapters 437 and 467 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

"Sec. 2. (a) The salary schedules and specific salaries established by or under Sections 7.1, 7.2, 7.3, 7.4, 7.5, 7.6, 7.7, 7.9(a), 7.9(b), 7.10, 7.11, 7.12, 7.13, 19.6, or 19.7 of Chapter 769 of the 1993 Session Laws shall remain until ~~July 28,~~ July 30, 1995, at the level set by or under those sections as of June 30, 1995.

(b) No person may receive a salary increase under G.S. 7A-102(c), 126-7 or 20-187.3(a) prior to ~~July 28,~~ July 30, 1995. No State employee or officer may prior to ~~July 28,~~ July 30, 1995, receive a merit increase or annual increment. No employee or officer subject to the teacher salary schedule or the school-based administrator salary schedule shall receive an increment until ~~July 28,~~ July 30, 1995."

1 Sec. 3. Section 8.1 of Chapter 771 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by
2 Chapters 358, 437, and 467 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

3 "Sec. 8.1. This act is effective upon ratification. Part II of this act is repealed on ~~July~~

7 Sec. 4. Subsection (h) of Section 69 of Chapter 1044 of the 1991 Session
8 Laws, as amended by Section 111 of Chapter 561 of the 1993 Session Laws, by Section
9 27.3 of Chapter 769 of the 1993 Session Laws, and by Chapters 358, 437, and 467 of the
10 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

11 "(h) Subsections (a) through (d) of this section expire ~~July 28, July 30, 1995.~~"

13 **EXTEND THE SUNSET FOR THE MEDIATION PROGRAM FOR THE**
14 **INDUSTRIAL COMMISSION**

15 Sec. 5. (a) Section 5 of Chapter 399 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by
16 Chapters 358, 437, and 467 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

17 "Sec. 5. Section 3 of this act is effective upon ratification. Sections 1, 2, and 4 of this
18 act become effective October 1, 1993, only if the General Assembly appropriates funds to
19 implement the purpose of these sections, expire ~~July 28, July 30, 1995,~~ and apply to
20 claims pending on or filed after the effective date."

21 (b) Section 5.4 of Chapter 679 of the 1993 Session Laws, as amended by Chapters
22 358, 437, and 467 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

23 "Sec. 5.4. Subsection (c) of G.S. 97-80 shall expire ~~July 28, July 30, 1995,~~ in
24 accordance with the provisions of Chapter 399 of the 1993 Session Laws, unless the
25 General Assembly amends Chapter 399 of the 1993 Session Laws to provide otherwise."

26 Sec. 6. Section 9 of Chapter 358 of the 1995 Session Laws, as amended by
27 Chapters 437 and 467 of the 1995 Session Laws, reads as rewritten:

28 "Sec. 9. This act is effective upon ratification, but ~~Sections 2 and 3~~ Section 2 and
29 Sections 6 through 8 expire ~~July 28, 1995.~~ upon ratification of House Bill 230, 1995
30 Regular Session."

31 Sec. 7. This act is effective upon ratification.
