A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO LIMIT THE AUTHORIZATION FOR PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS FROM
2 EMPLOYEES' SALARIES TO EMPLOYEES' ORGANIZATIONS.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. G.S. 143-3.3(g) reads as rewritten:

5 "(g) Payroll Deduction for Payments to Certain Employees' Associations Allowed.
6 – An employee of the State or any of its institutions, departments, bureaus, agencies or
7 commissions, or any of its ~~local boards of education or~~ community colleges, who is a
8 member of a domiciled employees' association that has at least 2,000 members, the
9 majority of whom are employees of the ~~State or public school employees,~~ State, may
10 authorize, in writing, the periodic deduction each payroll period from the employee's
11 salary or wages a designated lump sum to be paid to the employees' association. The
12 authorization shall remain in effect until revoked by the employee. A plan of payroll
13 deductions pursuant to this subsection for employees of the State and other association
14 members shall become void if the employees' association engages in collective
15 bargaining with the ~~State, State or~~ any political subdivision of the ~~State, or any local school~~
16 ~~administrative unit.~~ State. This subsection does not apply to county or municipal
17 governments or any local governmental ~~unit, except for local boards of education.~~ unit."

1 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
