2	AN ACT TO LIMIT THE AUTHORIZATION FOR PAYROLL DEDUCTIONS FROM
3	EMPLOYEES' SALARIES TO EMPLOYEES' ORGANIZATIONS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	Section 1. G.S. 143-3.3(g) reads as rewritten:
6	"(g) Payroll Deduction for Payments to Certain Employees' Associations Allowed.
7	- An employee of the State or any of its institutions, departments, bureaus, agencies or
8	commissions, or any of its local boards of education or community colleges, who is a
9	member of a domiciled employees' association that has at least 2,000 members, the
10	majority of whom are employees of the State or public school employees,-State, may
11	authorize, in writing, the periodic deduction each payroll period from the employee's
12	salary or wages a designated lump sum to be paid to the employees' association. The
13	authorization shall remain in effect until revoked by the employee. A plan of payroll
14	deductions pursuant to this subsection for employees of the State and other association
15	members shall become void if the employees' association engages in collective
16	bargaining with the State, State or any political subdivision of the State, or any local school
17	administrative unit. State. This subsection does not apply to county or municipal
18	governments or any local governmental unit, except for local boards of educationunit."
