A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO CHANGE THE TIME OF ELECTION OF THE AVERY COUNTY
2 BOARD OF EDUCATION FROM NOVEMBER TO MAY, AND TO PROVIDE
3 THAT THAT BOARD SHALL TAKE OFFICE IN JULY OF THE YEAR OF
4 THEIR ELECTION.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. Section 2 of Chapter 146, Session Laws of 1973, as rewritten by
8 Chapter 105 of the Session Laws of 1991, reads as rewritten:

9 "Sec. 2. Beginning in ~~1992-1996~~ and biennially thereafter, the election for members
10 of the Avery County Board of Education shall be held at the same time as the ~~general~~
11 ~~election-regular primary~~ for county officers, and shall be conducted on a nonpartisan
12 plurality basis, with the results determined in accordance with G.S. 163-292. Candidates
13 shall file notice of candidacy ~~not earlier than 12:00 noon on the first Friday in July, and not~~
14 ~~later than 12:00 noon on the first Friday in August.~~ at the same time as candidates for county
15 office under G.S. 163-106."

16 Sec. 2. (a) Notwithstanding Sections 4 and 5 of Chapter 146, Session Laws of
17 1973, beginning in 1996 terms of office of the members of the Avery County Board of
18 Education commence on the first Monday in July of the year of their election, except if
19 that date is the Fourth of July, then the terms commence on the second Monday in July.

1 (b) Terms of office of members of the Avery County Board of Education elected
2 in 1992 and 1994 shall expire on the date set by subsection (a) of this section for their
3 successors to take office.

4 Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
