March 30, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE TOWN OF ROUGEMONT. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. A Charter for the Town of Rougemont is enacted to read: "CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF ROUGEMONT. "CHAPTER I. "INCORPORATION AND CORPORATE POWERS. "Section 1.1. **Incorporation and Corporate Powers.** The inhabitants of the Town of Rougemont are a body corporate and politic under the name 'Town of Rougemont'. Under that name they have all the powers, duties, rights, privileges, and immunities conferred and imposed on cities by the general law of North Carolina. "Sec. 1.2. Map. An official map of the Town, showing the current boundaries, is maintained permanently in the office of the Town Clerk and is available for public inspection. A true copy of such shall be filed in the office of the Durham County Register of Deeds. "CHAPTER II. "CORPORATE BOUNDARIES.

"Sec. 2.1. Town Boundaries. Until modified in accordance with law the boundaries

of the Town of Rougemont are as follows:
