A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT FIRE FIGHTERS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL  
2 SERVICE PERSONNEL MAY POSSESS OR CARRY WEAPONS ON SCHOOL  
3 GROUNDS WHEN DISCHARGING THEIR OFFICIAL DUTIES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 14-269(g) reads as rewritten:

7 "(g) This section shall not apply to:

8 (1) A weapon used solely for educational or school-sanctioned ceremonial  
9 purposes, or used in a school-approved program conducted under the  
10 supervision of an adult whose supervision has been approved by the  
11 school authority;

12 (2) Armed forces personnel, officers and soldiers of the militia and national  
13 guard, law-enforcement personnel, ~~and fire fighters, emergency medical~~  
14 personnel, and any private police employed by an educational  
15 institution, when acting in the discharge of their official duties; or

16 (3) Home schools as defined in G.S. 115C-563(a)."

17 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995.
