1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO MAKE IT A CLASS F FELONY TO ASSAULT A LAW
3 ENFORCEMENT OFFICER.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. Article 8 of Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by
6 adding a new section to read:

7 "**§ 14-32.3. Assault on a law enforcement officer with intent to inflict serious harm.**

8 Any person who assaults a law enforcement officer when the officer is discharging or
9 attempting to discharge the officer's official duties and inflicts or attempts to inflict
10 serious injury is guilty of a Class F felony."

11 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995, and applies to offenses
12 committed on or after that date.
