A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ADJUST THE COMPENSATION OF EMERGENCY SUPERIOR
COURT JUDGES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 7A-52(b) reads as rewritten:

"(b) In addition to the compensation or retirement allowance the judge would otherwise be entitled to receive by law, each emergency judge of the district or superior court who is assigned to temporary active service by the Chief Justice shall be paid by the State the judge's actual expenses, plus ~~two hundred dollars (\$250.00) for each day of active service rendered upon recall.~~ seventy-five percent (75%) of the daily compensation of an active, regular judge with five years' longevity on the court to which the emergency judge is assigned. The daily compensation of an active, regular judge, as used in this subsection, shall be computed by the Administrative Office of the Courts for active, regular superior and district court judges by taking into consideration the annual salary, with five years' longevity, and the number of days per year that each of those judges is actually assigned to hold court. No recalled retired trial judge shall receive from the State total annual compensation for judicial services in excess of that received by an active judge of the bench to which the judge is recalled."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
