A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO REDUCE THE MINIMUM NUMBER OF BEDS IN THE STATE
2 VETERANS HOME TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN FAYETTEVILLE.

3 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

4 Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 31 of Chapter 561 of the 1993 Session
5 Laws reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) Funds appropriated in this act for the State Veterans Home in Fayetteville shall
7 be used to construct at least ~~150~~120 beds at the facility. It is the intent of the General
8 Assembly that this appropriation be the complete appropriation for this facility and that
9 no additional State capital funds be appropriated."

10 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
