The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. Subsection (b) of Section 31 of Chapter 561 of the 1993 Session Laws reads as rewritten: Funds appropriated in this act for the State Veterans Home in Fayetteville shall

be used to construct at least 150-120 beds at the facility. It is the intent of the General

Assembly that this appropriation be the complete appropriation for this facility and that

no additional State capital funds be appropriated." Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
