A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO DIRECT THE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW COMMISSION TO
2 STUDY AND MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS CONCERNING DRINKING
3 WATER TESTING REQUIREMENTS AND MINIMIZATION OF THE COST OF
4 DRINKING WATER TESTS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 Section 1. The Environmental Review Commission shall study drinking water
8 testing requirements and the fees charged by private laboratories to perform drinking
9 water tests required under the federal Safe Drinking Water Act. The Commission may
10 recommend a method of minimizing the costs for the drinking water tests, which may
11 include requiring the State Laboratory to perform the tests at a reduced cost. The
12 Environmental Review Commission shall report to the General Assembly on or before
13 the day on which the 1996 Regular Session of the General Assembly convenes.

14 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
