A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO IMPLEMENT
SALARY RANGES FOR SCHOOL CENTRAL OFFICE PERSONNEL.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. The following monthly salary ranges apply to public school assistant superintendents, directors, supervisors, and finance officers for the 1995-96 fiscal year:

3 The local board of education shall determine the appropriate category and placement for
4 each assistant superintendent, director, supervisor, or finance officer, within the salary
5 ranges and within funds appropriated by the General Assembly for central office
6 administrators and superintendents. The category in which an employee is placed shall
7 be included in the contract of any employee hired after July 1, 1995.

8 Sec. 2. The following monthly salary ranges apply to public school
9 superintendents for the 1995-96 fiscal year:(1) Superintendent I (Up to 2,500 ADM):
10 \$3,852 - \$6,199

11 (2) Superintendent II (2,501 - 5,000 ADM): \$4,088 - \$6,578

12 (3) Superintendent III (5,001 - 10,000 ADM): \$4,338 - \$6,981

13 (4) Superintendent IV (10,001 - 25,000 ADM): \$4,604 - \$7,408

14 (5) Superintendent V (Over 25,000 ADM): \$4,886 - \$7,861
15 The local board of education shall determine the appropriate category and placement for the superintendent
16 based on the average daily membership of the local school administrative unit and within
17 funds appropriated by the General Assembly for central officer administrators and
18 superintendents.

19 Sec. 3. Longevity pay for superintendents, assistant superintendents, directors,
20 supervisors, and finance officers shall be as provided for State employees.

21 Sec. 4. The State Board of Education shall adopt a new funding allotment
22 category for public school central office administrators. Funds allocated in that category
23 to a local school administrative unit shall not exceed the funds appropriated for that
24 purpose by the General Assembly. The State Board shall not permit local school
25 administrative units to transfer funds from other funding categories to the new category
26 for public school central office administrators.

27 Sec. 5. This act shall not be construed to obligate the General Assembly to
28 appropriate funds for the implementation of the salary ranges set out in this act.

29 Sec. 6. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
