A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO DIRECT THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO IMPLEMENT SALARY SCHEDULES FOR SCHOOL CENTRAL OFFICE PERSONNEL.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. To the extent that the State Board of Education phases in this salary schedule within funds appropriated by the General Assembly for that purpose, the following salary schedule applies to public school assistant superintendents, associate superintendents, directors, supervisors, and finance officers, for the 1995-96 fiscal year:

31 The local board of education shall determine the appropriate category for each assistant  
 32 superintendent, associate superintendent, director, supervisor, or finance officers. That  
 33 category in which an employee is placed shall be included in the contract of any  
 34 employee hired after July 1, 1995.

35 Sec. 2. To the extent that the State Board of Education phases in this salary  
 36 schedule within funds appropriated by the General Assembly for that purpose, the  
 37 following salary schedule applies to public school superintendents for the 1995-96 fiscal

32 The local board of education shall determine the appropriate category for the  
 33 superintendent based on the average daily membership of the local school administrative  
 34 unit.

35 Sec. 3. The local board of education shall determine the placement of an  
 36 educationally licensed central office administrator on a step within a category of the  
 37 appropriate salary schedule reflecting one step for every year on their North Carolina  
 38 professional educator license, and an additional step for every three years of experience  
 39 as principal, central office administrator, or equivalent administrator experience as  
 40 defined by the Department of Public Instruction.

41 Sec. 4. Longevity pay for superintendents, assistant superintendents, associate  
 42 superintendents, directors, supervisors, and finance officers, shall be as provided for State  
 43 employees.

1           Sec. 5. The State Board of Education shall adopt a new funding allotment  
2 category for public school central office administrators. Funds allocated in that category  
3 to a local school administrative unit shall not exceed two percent (2%) of the total State  
4 funds allocated to the local school administrative unit. The State Board shall not permit  
5 local school administrative units to transfer funds from other funding categories to the  
6 new category for public school central office administrators.

7           Sec. 6. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local  
8 School Administrative Units the sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000) for the 1995-96  
9 fiscal year and the sum of six million dollars (\$6,000,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to  
10 fund the provisions of this act.

11           Sec. 7. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
