A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS FOR GRANTS TO LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL BUILDING CAPITAL PROJECTS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Appropriation. – There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Public School Building Grant Fund created in this act in the Department of State Treasurer the sum of two hundred fifty million dollars (\$250,000,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty million dollars (\$250,000,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to be used for public school building capital projects as provided in this act.

Sec. 2. Use of Funds. – There is created in the Department of State Treasurer a special fund to be designated "Public School Building Grant Fund". Moneys in the Public School Building Grant Fund shall be used only for the purpose of making grants to local school administrative units for paying the cost of providing public school buildings including the planning, construction, reconstruction, enlargement, improvement, repair, or renovation of public school buildings, the purchase of land necessary for immediate construction of school buildings, and other related capital outlay projects constituting facilities for individual schools that are used for instructional and related purposes, but not including centralized administration, maintenance, or other facilities.

Sec. 3. Reports. – The Director of the Budget shall provide quarterly reports to the State Board of Education, the General Assembly, and the Fiscal Research Division on the expenditure of moneys from the Public School Building Grant Fund.

Sec. 4. Allocation. – Funds in the Public School Building Grant Fund shall be allocated among the local school administrative units of the State as follows:
