A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FIVE HUNDRED MILLION DOLLARS FOR GRANTS
TO LOCAL SCHOOL ADMINISTRATIVE UNITS FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL
BUILDING CAPITAL PROJECTS.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Appropriation. – There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Public School Building Grant Fund created in this act in the Department of State Treasurer the sum of two hundred fifty million dollars (\$250,000,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty million dollars (\$250,000,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to be used for public school building capital projects as provided in this act.

Sec. 2. Use of Funds. – There is created in the Department of State Treasurer a special fund to be designated "Public School Building Grant Fund". Moneys in the Public School Building Grant Fund shall be used only for the purpose of making grants to local school administrative units for paying the cost of providing public school buildings including the planning, construction, reconstruction, enlargement, improvement, repair, or renovation of public school buildings, the purchase of land necessary for immediate construction of school buildings, and other related capital outlay projects constituting facilities for individual schools that are used for instructional and related purposes, but not including centralized administration, maintenance, or other facilities.

1 Sec. 3. Reports. – The Director of the Budget shall provide quarterly reports to
2 the State Board of Education, the General Assembly, and the Fiscal Research Division on
3 the expenditure of moneys from the Public School Building Grant Fund.

4 Sec. 4. Allocation. – Funds in the Public School Building Grant Fund shall be
5 allocated among the local school administrative units of the State as follows:

 42 If two or more local school administrative units are consolidated into one unit,
 43 the amount allocated above to the units shall be allocated to the merged unit.

1 Funds disbursed under this act shall be administered and supervised by the
2 Director of the Budget and shall be used only for the purposes provided in this act. Each
3 school administrative unit shall submit to the Director of the Budget its plans for the
4 expenditure of funds allocated under this act. After the Director of the Budget
5 determines that a school administrative unit's planned expenditure of part or all of the
6 funds allocated to it is within the purposes provided in this act, the Director shall make
7 the funds to which the plans apply available to the school administrative unit.

8 Sec. 5. Reversion. – The funds appropriated in this act shall not revert but
9 shall remain available until used for the purposes provided in this act.

10 Sec. 6. Effective Date. – This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
