Referred to: Appropriations May 4, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES ESTABLISH A STATE NUTRITION **ASSISTANCE** TO PROGRAM. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Human Resources the sum of one million two hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) for each year of the 1995-97 fiscal biennium to establish and operate a State Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) to allow the six North Carolina food banks to purchase commodities that would be given to SNAP-certified pantries across the State so as to provide families and children with the nutrients they need. These funds shall be allocated as follows: \$1,000,000 each fiscal year to purchase the commodities; and (1) \$200,000 each fiscal year for transporting, storing, and handling the (2)

> commodities at the food bank level. Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
