A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO ESTABLISH PILOT PROGRAMS THAT OFFER EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES AT SITES LOCATED IN AREAS AWAY FROM THE CAMPUSES OF THE CONSTITUENT INSTITUTIONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year to establish pilot programs at sites located away from campuses of the constituent institutions and expand educational opportunities at those sites. The Board of Governors shall consider as sites for the pilot projects, those areas that are easily available to military personnel and other citizens so that both can receive maximum benefits from the increased educational opportunities.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
