2	AN ACT TO PUNISH AS A FELONY AN ASSAULT COMMITTED WITH INTENT
3	TO KILL OR INTENT TO INFLICT EXTREMELY SERIOUS INJURY AND AN
4	ASSAULT INFLICTING EXTREMELY SERIOUS INJURY.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
7	section to read:
8	"§ 14-32.3. Felonious assault with intent to kill or inflict extremely serious injury or
9	inflicting extremely serious injury; punishment.
10	(a) For purposes of this section, extremely serious injury means injury resulting in:
11	(1) <u>Permanent physical or mental handicap or disability to another person;</u>
12	<u>or</u>
13	(2) <u>Protracted hospitalization of another person.</u>
14	(b) Any person who assaults another person and inflicts extremely serious injury
15	shall be punished as a Class H felon.
16	(c) Any person who assaults another person with intent to kill or intent to inflict
17	extremely serious injury and who inflicts serious injury shall be punished as a Class H
18	<u>felon.</u> "
19	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 1995, and applies to offenses
20	occurring on or after that date.
