A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO PLACE CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON THE SITING OF SWINE
HOUSES AND LAGOONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new
Article to read:

"ARTICLE 67.

"SWINE INDUSTRY.

"§ 106-800. Requirements for siting swine houses and lagoons.

(a) Swine houses and lagoons that are components of a swine operation shall be located at least 1,500 feet from any residence and at least 2,500 feet from any school, hospital, church, or other building that is occupied by people on a regular basis.

(b) Swine houses and lagoons that are components of a swine operation may be sited closer to a residence than is allowed under subsection (a) of this section when the residence is owned by the owner of the swine operation.

(c) As used in this section, 'swine operation' means a facility that is used, or that is capable of being used, for the production of 250 or more swine."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective September 1, 1995, and applies to any swine operation for which a site evaluation is conducted on or after that date.
