A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PLACE CERTAIN RESTRICTIONS ON THE SITING OF SWINE HOUSES AND LAGOONS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new Article to read:

"§ 106-800. Requirements for siting swine houses and lagoons.

- (a) Swine houses and lagoons that are components of a swine operation shall be located at least 1,500 feet from any residence that is not abandoned and at least 2,500 feet from any school, hospital, church, or other building that is occupied by people on a regular basis.
- (b) Swine houses and lagoons that are components of a swine operation may be sited closer to a residence than is allowed under subsection (a) of this section:
 - (1) If the owner of the residence indicates his or her consent in a statement signed by the owner, notarized, and filed in the register of deeds' office in the county in which the property is located; or

1	(2) When the residence is owned by the owner of the swine operation.
2	(c) As used in this section, 'swine operation' means a facility that is used, or that is
3	capable of being used, for the production of 250 or more swine."
4	Sec. 2. This act becomes effective September 1, 1995, and applies to any
5	swine operation for which a site evaluation is conducted on or after that date.
