A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE STUDY OF WATER QUALITY AND THE ENHANCEMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL EDUCATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources the sum of two hundred fourteen thousand, nine hundred thirty-two dollars (\$214,932) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for three positions and operating expenses for enhancement of environmental education programs.

- Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Environmental Management, the sum of nine hundred thousand dollars (\$900,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to study and prepare a model of atmospheric deposition of nitrogen.
- Sec. 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Environmental Management, the sum of nine hundred thirteen thousand dollars (\$913,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for four positions and operating expenses for monitoring activities including equipment and contract laboratory support.
- Sec. 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Environmental Management,
