| 7  | Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of               |
| 8  | Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Environmental Health, the sum     |
| 9  | of four hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$425,000) for the 1996-1997 fiscal year to |
| 10 | implement a waiver program pursuant to the regulations of the United States               |
| 11 | Environmental Protection Agency for drinking water tests. The Division of                 |
| 12 | Environmental Health shall consider contracting with private industry to conduct the      |
| 13 | necessary studies and negotiate the waivers with the United States Environmental          |
| 14 | Protection Agency.  |
| 15 | Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.  |
