A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENT,
HEALTH, AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO PROVIDE LIFE-SUSTAINING
MEDICATION FOR ELIGIBLE PERSONS INFECTED WITH HIV.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Environment, Health, and Natural Resources, Division of Adult Health, the sum of five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year to provide life-sustaining medications for medically indigent, non-Medicaid eligible people infected with the human immunodeficiency virus, as defined in rules adopted by the Commission for Health Services.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
