A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO CREATE A NEW OFFENSE OF THIRD DEGREE TRESPASS IN
SURRY COUNTY.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. (a) Offense. – A person commits the offense of third degree trespass if, without written authorization, the person enters or remains on the premises of another for the purpose of hunting, fishing, trapping, loitering, or operating an all-terrain vehicle.

(b) Classification. – Third degree trespass is a Class 3 misdemeanor.

Sec. 2. This act applies only to Surry County.

Sec. 3. This act becomes effective December 1, 1996, and applies to offenses occurring on or after that date.
