SENATE BILL 1418

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS REQUESTED BY
3 COALITION 2001.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of
6 Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, Department
7 of Human Resources, the sum of five million nine hundred fifty thousand dollars
8 (\$5,950,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for capital mental health, developmental
9 disabilities, and substance abuse services projects requested by Coalition 2001. These
10 funds shall be allocated as follows:

11 (1) Adult Mental Health:

12 a. \$75,000 for assistive listening devices; and

13 b. \$300,000 for equipment for psychosocial clubhouses; and

14 (2) Child Mental Health:

15 a. \$300,000 for residential facilities, which will provide \$50,000 for
16 each of six group homes; and

17 b. \$1,100,000 for five regional high management homes to provide
18 residential "SAY" treatment; and

19 (3) Developmental Disabilities:

- 1 a. \$2,125,000 for vocational services;
2 b. \$100,000 for supported living; and
3 c. \$2,000,000 for developmental day centers; and
4 (4) Substance Abuse:
5 a. \$750,000 for treatment facilities for women and their children;
6 and
7 b. \$500,000 for child and adolescent regional residential programs.
8 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996
