There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of five million nine hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$5,950,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for capital mental health, developmental disabilities, and substance abuse services projects requested by Coalition 2001. These funds shall be allocated as follows: (1) Adult Mental Health: \$75,000 for assistive listening devices; and \$300,000 for equipment for psychosocial clubhouses; and h (2) Child Mental Health: \$300,000 for residential facilities, which will provide \$50,000 for a. each of six group homes; and \$1,100,000 for five regional high management homes to provide b.
