A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN EXPERIENCE CREDIT FOR THE PRINCIPAL CLERKS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 120-37(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) The principal clerks shall be full-time officers. Each principal clerk shall be entitled to other benefits available to permanent legislative employees and shall be paid an annual salary of fifty-five thousand eighty dollars (\$55,080) payable monthly. The principal clerks shall also receive as part of their salary the amount of one percent (1%) of their salary established by this section multiplied by the number of full years that they have served as principal clerks. The Legislative Services Commission shall review the salary of the principal clerks prior to submission of the proposed operating budget of the General Assembly to the Governor and Advisory Budget Commission and shall make appropriate recommendations for changes in those salaries. Any changes enacted by the General Assembly shall be by amendment to this paragraph."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
