**A BILL TO BE ENTITLED**

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND  
IMPLEMENTATION AT HILLSIDE MODEL HIGH SCHOOL OF A MODEL  
SITE-BASED MANAGEMENT PROGRAM.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to State Aid to Local School Administrative Units the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year. These funds shall be used by the Durham County School Administrative Unit, in collaboration with university, business, and community-based organizations, for the development and implementation at Hillside Model High School of a model site-based management program. This program shall consist of a systematic approach of modeling new ways to serve school communities through professional development designed and evaluated in terms of increased student performance.

The Durham County Board of Education shall report to the State Board of Education and the Joint Legislative Education Oversight Committee prior to May 1, 1997, on the use of these funds and models developed at Hillside Model High School that may be of use to other school administrative units across the State.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
