A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO COMMUNITY-BASED ALTERNATIVE SERVICES IN ACCORDANCE WITH RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE RESEARCH TRIANGLE INSTITUTE'S COMPREHENSIVE STUDY OF THE DIVISION OF YOUTH SERVICES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Division of Youth Services, Department of Human Resources, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for the permanent expansion of community-based alternative services. Twenty-five percent (25%) of these funds shall be allocated equally among all 100 counties and seventy-five percent (75%) shall be allocated to the counties on a per capita basis.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1996.
