A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE SENATE APPOINTMENTS TO THE RULES
2 REVIEW COMMISSION SHALL BE MADE BY THE PRESIDENT PRO
3 TEMPORE RATHER THAN THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 143B-30.1(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) The Rules Review Commission is created. The Commission shall consist of
8 eight members to be appointed by the General Assembly, four upon the recommendation
9 of the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and four upon the recommendation of the
10 Speaker of the House of Representatives. These appointments shall be made in
11 accordance with G.S. 120-121, and vacancies in these appointments shall be filled in
12 accordance with G.S. 120-122. Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, all
13 appointees shall serve two-year terms."

14 Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification. This act does not affect the
15 terms of the members of the Rules Review Commission appointed by the General
16 Assembly upon the recommendation of the President of the Senate before the effective
17 date of this act.
