S 1 SENATE BILL 331 Short Title: Truck Weight Tolerances Limits. (Public) Sponsors: Senators Hoyle, Plyler, Martin of Pitt, Conder, Hobbs, Odom, Dannelly, Kerr, Forrester, and Davis. Referred to: Transportation March 8, 1995 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO PROVIDE A LIMITED TOLERANCE FOR EXISTING TRUCK WEIGHTS. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. G.S. 20-118(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: "(13) All vehicles may exceed the interior axle-group and maximum weight limits set forth in subdivision (b)(3) of this section by a tolerance of ten percent (10%), subject to the axle weight limitations set forth in subdivisions (b)(1) and (b)(2) of this section and a maximum weight limit of 80,000 pounds. These exceptions do not apply to restricted, posted bridge structures or apply to vehicles operating on interstate highways." Sec. 2. G.S. 20-118(e) reads as rewritten: "(e) Penalties. -Except as provided in subdivision (2) of this subsection, for each (1) violation of the single-axle or tandem-axle weight limits set in subdivision (b)(1), (b)(2), or (b)(4) of this section, the Department of Transportation shall assess a civil penalty against the owner or registrant of the vehicle in accordance with the following schedule: for the first

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- 1,000 pounds or any part thereof, four cents (4ϕ) per pound; for the next 1,000 pounds or any part thereof, six cents (6ϕ) per pound; and for each additional pound, ten cents (10ϕ) per pound. These penalties apply separately to each weight limit violated. In all cases of violation of the weight limitation, the penalty shall be computed and assessed on each pound of weight in excess of the maximum permitted.
- (2) The penalty for a violation of the single-axle or tandem-axle weight limits by a vehicle that is transporting an item listed in subdivision (c)(5) of this section is one-half of the amount it would otherwise be under subdivision (1) of this subsection.
- (3) Except as provided in subdivision (4) of this subsection, for a violation of an axle-group weight limit set in subdivision (b)(3) of this section, the Department of Transportation shall assess a civil penalty against the owner or registrant of the motor vehicle in accordance with the following schedule: for the first 2,000 pounds or any part thereof, two cents (2¢) per pound; for the next 3,000 pounds or any part thereof, four cents (4¢) per pound; for each pound in excess of 5,000 pounds, ten cents (10¢) per pound. These penalties apply separately to each axlegroup weight limit violated. The penalty shall be assessed on each pound of weight in excess of the maximum permitted, excluding tolerance.
- (4) The penalty for a violation of an axle-group weight limit by a vehicle that is transporting an item listed in subdivision (c)(5) of this section is one-half of the amount it would otherwise be under subdivision (3) of this subsection.
- (5) A violation of a weight limit in this section is not punishable under G.S. 20-176."
- Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
