CHAPTER 92  
SENATE BILL 377

AN ACT INCLUDING WITHIN THE DEFINITION OF AN ABANDONED VEHICLE THOSE LEFT ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE CITY OF WINSTON-SALEM FOR MORE THAN FORTY-EIGHT HOURS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 160A-303(b)(4) reads as rewritten:

"(4) Is left on any public street or highway for longer than seven ~~days~~  
days, or on:  
a. U.S. Highway 52;  
b. Interstate Highway 40; or  
c. Business Interstate Highway 40,  
within the corporate limits of the City of Winston-Salem for longer  
than 48 hours."

Sec. 2. This act applies to the City of Winston-Salem only.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.

In the General Assembly read three times and ratified this the 22nd day of May, 1995.
