A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF PODIATRY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 90-202.2 reads as rewritten:

"§ 90-202.2. 'Podiatry' defined.

Podiatry as defined by this Article is the surgical or medical or mechanical treatment of all ailments conditions of the human foot, foot and ankle, and their related soft tissue structures, except the amputation of the entire foot or toes or the administration of an anesthetic other than local and except the correction of clubfoot deformity and triple arthrodesis. local."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
