A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF PODIATRY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 90-202.2 reads as rewritten:

"§ 90-202.2. 'Podiatry' defined.

~~Podiatry as defined by this Article is the surgical or medical or mechanical treatment of all ailments of the human foot, except the amputation of the foot or toes or the administration of an anesthetic other than local and except the correction of clubfoot deformity and triple arthrodesis.~~

Podiatry as defined by this Article is the surgical, medical, or mechanical treatment of all conditions of the human foot and ankle, and their related soft tissue structures to the level of the myotendinous junction. Excluded from the definition of podiatry is the amputation of the entire foot, the administration of an anesthetic other than local, and the surgical correction of clubfoot of an infant two years of age or less."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
