SENATE BILL 428

Short Title: Forsyth Firemen's Fund.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW REGARDING THE SUPPLEMENTAL WELFARE
FUND FOR FIREMEN IN FORSYTH COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Section 2(d) of Chapter 418 of the 1969 Session Laws reads as
rewritten:

"(d) at the close of each calendar year when the amount of funds in the Local Relief
Fund shall, by reason of disbursements authorized by ~~G.S. 118-7~~, G.S. 58-84-35, be less
than ~~Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)~~, nine thousand dollars (\$9,000), transfer from
the Supplemental Welfare Fund an amount sufficient to maintain in the Local Relief
Fund the sum of ~~Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00)~~, nine thousand dollars (\$9,000)."

Sec. 2. None of the provisions of this act shall create a liability for the Forsyth
County Supplemental Welfare Fund for Firemen or for the State unless sufficient current
assets are available in the fund to pay fully for the liability.

Sec. 3. This act is effective upon ratification.
