A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE A COUNTY DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL SERVICES TO
2 DELEGATE THE FUNCTION OF ISSUING YOUTH EMPLOYMENT
3 CERTIFICATES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 Section 1. G.S. 95-25.5(a) reads as rewritten:

7 "(a) No youth under 18 years of age shall be employed by any employer in any
8 occupation without a youth employment certificate unless specifically exempted. The
9 Commissioner of Labor shall prescribe regulations for youths and employers concerning
10 the issuance, maintenance and revocation of certificates. Certificates will be issued by
11 county directors of social ~~services, services or their designees,~~ subject to review by the
12 Department of Labor; provided, the Commissioner may by regulation require that the
13 Department of Labor issue certificates for occupations with unusual or unique
14 characteristics."

15 Sec. 2. G.S. 108A-14(b) reads as rewritten:

16 "(b) The director may delegate ~~to one or more members of his staff in writing~~ the
17 authority to act as ~~his~~ the director's representative. The director may limit the delegated
18 authority of his representative to specific tasks or areas of expertise."

19 Sec. 3. This act applies to counties with a population of 400,000 and above.

20 Sec. 4. This act is effective upon ratification.
