1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DIVISION OF TRAVEL AND 3 TOURISM FOR AN ADVERTISING CAMPAIGN PROMOTING NORTH 4 CAROLINA AS A TRAVEL DESTINATION. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 6 Commerce, Division of Travel and Tourism, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) 7 for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 1996-8 97 fiscal year for promotional advertising in the Division of Travel and Tourism. The 9 Division shall use the funds to promote North Carolina as a travel destination. The 10 Division shall not use these funds for personnel or for any other overhead expenditures. 11 Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995. 12
