Section 1. Part 2 of Article 3 of Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:

"§ 20-49.1. Additional police authority of Division.

In addition to the powers set out in G.S. 20-49, officers of the Division have the following powers:

- (1) To make arrests upon view and without warrant for a violation of a law that does not regulate the operation of vehicles or the use of the highways if the violation occurs in the officer's presence while the officer is engaged in enforcing a law that regulates the operation of vehicles or the use of the highways.
- To stop and detain a person for a violation of a law committed in or out 16 (2) of their presence if the violation occurs when the officer is engaged in 17 enforcing a law that regulates the operation of vehicles or the use of the 18
