A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT THE SITE OF THE
NORTH CAROLINA INDIAN CULTURAL CENTER.**

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Administration the sum of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year and the sum of one hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$175,000) for the 1996-97 fiscal year for improvements on the site of the North Carolina Indian Cultural Center, to be allocated as follows:

- (1) \$100,000 for the historic preservation of the Henry Berry Lowry House and for the purchase of household furnishings and artifacts, to be matched by \$50,000 in private sector funds;
- (2) \$40,000 for cleanup of the Lumber River and lake at the Indian Cultural Center site, and for the design and construction of river walks at the site; and
- (3) \$35,000 for security and maintenance of the grounds, and for upgrade of the swimming pool and amphitheater.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
