A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO REGULATE THE AFTER-DEATH SALES OF CEMETERY
MERCHANDISE OR SERVICES AT THE RESIDENCE OF THE DECEASED.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. Article 9 of Chapter 65 of the General Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to read:

"§ 65-68.1. Sales after death.

No person, other than an employee or agent of a licensed cemetery company,
cemetery sales organization, or cemetery management group, shall sell or offer to sell
cemetery merchandise or services after the death of the individual for whom the
merchandise or services are intended, at the residence of the prospective consumer.

A contract entered into in violation of this section may be voided by the consumer."

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 1995.
