A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO ALLOW THE ASSIGNMENT OF CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE IN FAVOR OF INSURANCE COMPANIES FOR PROPERTY AND CASUALTY INSURANCE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. G.S. 143-3.3(c) reads as rewritten:

"(c) Assignments in Favor of Certain Entities Allowed. – This section does not apply to an assignment in favor of:

(1) A hospital.

(2) A building and loan association.

(3) A uniform rental firm in order to allow an employee of the Department of Transportation to rent uniforms that include day-glo orange shirts or vests as required by federal and State law.

(4) An insurance company for medical, hospital, disability, ~~or life insurance-~~ insurance, or property and casualty insurance."

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
