1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO REENACT THE PROVISION ALLOWING BOARDS OF ELECTIONS
3	TO KEEP POLLS OPEN TO 9:30 P.M. UNDER CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES,
4	WHICH WAS ENACTED IN 1991 BUT EXPIRED ON JANUARY 1, 1995.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	Section 1. G.S. 163-2 reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 163-2. Hours of primaries and elections.
8	In all primaries, general elections, special elections, and referenda held in this State,
9	including those held in and for municipalities and special districts, the polls shall be open
10	at 6:30 A.M., and shall be closed at 7:30 P.M.: Provided, however, that at all voting
11	places at which voting machines are used that whenever:
12	(1) There are insufficient numbers of ballots;
13	(2) There are insufficient numbers of polling books;
14	(3) There are multiple breakdowns in voting equipment;
15	(4) The openings of the polls are delayed; or
16	(5) There are other irregularities
17	which cause undue delays in the voting process, the responsible county board of elections
18	may permit the polls to remain open until 8:30-9:30 P.M."
19	Sec. 2. This act is effective upon ratification.
