A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO NORTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY TO STUDY REDUCING THE LEVEL OF TAR IN CIGARETTES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Section 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 1995-96 fiscal year for North Carolina State University to conduct research into reducing the level of tar in cigarettes.

Sec. 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 1995.
